# Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) Bootcamp

## Description

The CCNA Bootcamp combines the Interconnecting Cisco Networking Devices Part 1 (ICND1) and Interconnecting Cisco Network Devices Part 2 (ICND2) into one 5 day instructor-led course. Instructors are Senior IT professionals so while the CCNA Boot Camp is the quickest way of training for students seeking certification as a Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) it is not suitable for students who are completely new to Cisco. It is ideally suited to students who need to recertify or already have some experience on the command line. Students should be aware that the bootcamp has a higher pace and will have extended hours of teaching on most days.
